14 **WHEREAS** on December 19, 2022 Security National Insurance Company (“Security National”)
15 applied to the Board for approval of rating program changes under the Supplemental filing option
16 for its Private Passenger Automobiles category of automobile insurance; and

18 **WHEREAS** Security National proposed to introduce new rating variables for its Grand Touring
19 Solution endorsement offering; and

21 **WHEREAS** the overall rate level impact of the proposal is 0.41%; and

23 **WHEREAS** the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines and is
24 supported; and

26 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
27 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
28 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
29 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.


32 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
