| 26 | WHEREAS on February 9, 2024 Aviva submitted a new Supplemental filing in response to A.I. |
| 27 | 8(2024) in which it proposed to withdraw the approved changes to the Combined Discount and |

| 30 | WHEREAS Aviva estimated the overall rate level impact of the proposed changes to be +0.3%; |
