18	jurisdictions in which Facility operates; and
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20	WHEREAS the proposal results in an overall rate level impact of 0.0%; and
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22	WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and
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24	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
25	circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
26	financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the <b>Automobile Insurance Act</b> or the
27	Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.

1. The proposal received April 19, 2024 from Facility Association for approval to implement endorsement and rating rule changes is approved to be effective no sooner than October 1, 2024 for new business and renewals.
