1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the **Automobile**
2 **Insurance Act**, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,
3 as amended and regulations
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
7 Tokio Marine and Nichido Fire Insurance
8 Company for approval to implement a
9 revised rating program for its
10 Miscellaneous Vehicles category of
11 automobile insurance.

14 **WHEREAS** on August 19, 2024 Tokio Marine and Nichido Fire Insurance Company (“Tokio
15 Marine”) applied to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the IAO filing option
16 for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance, including Motorcycles, ATVs,
17 Motorized Snow Vehicles and Motorhomes; and
18

19 **WHEREAS** the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating
20 program accepted for use by the Board; and

22 **WHEREAS** Tokio Marine does not have sufficient volume to justify a rating program based on
23 company-specific data; and
24

25 **WHEREAS** Tokio Marine proposed to adopt the IAO rating program for Miscellaneous Vehicles
26 accepted for use by the Board in information bulletin A.I. 2024-04; and

28 **WHEREAS** Tokio Marine also proposed the following changes:

- 29 • adopt the 2024 CLEAR rate group table for Motorcycles;
30 • rating rule adjustments;
31 • surcharge adjustments; and
32 • changes to endorsement pricing; and

34 **WHEREAS** Tokio Marine has no exposures and the proposed rating program results in an overall
35 rate level change of 0.0%; and

1 **WHEREAS** the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines; and

3 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
4 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
5 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
6 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

9 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

11 1. The revised rating program received August 19, 2024 from Tokio Marine and Nichido Fire
12 Insurance Company for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance is
13 approved to be effective no sooner than February 24, 2025 for new business and April 11,
14 2025 for renewals.
