1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the **Automobile**
2 **Insurance Act**, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,
3 as amended and regulations
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
7 Tokio Marine and Nichido Fire Insurance
8 Company Ltd. for approval to implement
9 a revised rating program for its
10 Miscellaneous Vehicles category of
11 automobile insurance.

14 **WHEREAS** on August 19, 2024 Tokio Marine and Nichido Fire Insurance Company Ltd. (“Tokio
15 Marine”) applied to the Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory
16 Simplified filing option for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance, including
17 Antique Vehicles, and Trailers and Camper Units; and

19 **WHEREAS** Tokio Marine proposed no change to its rates or rating elements, resulting in a 0%
20 overall rate level change; and

22 **WHEREAS** Tokio Marine did not perform an actuarial analysis in support of its proposal due to its
23 zero-exposure count; and

25 **WHEREAS** the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Mandatory Simplified Filing
26 Guidelines; and


28 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
29 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
30 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
31 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

- 3 1. The revised rating program received August 19, 2024 from Tokio Marine and Nichido Fire
4 Insurance Company Ltd. for its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance is
5 approved to be effective no sooner than February 24, 2025 for new business and April 11,
6 2025 for renewals.
