IN THE MATTER OF the Automobile 1 2 Insurance Act, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, 3 as amended and regulations 4 thereunder; and 5 6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by 7 Security National Insurance Company for 8 approval to implement rating program 9 changes for its Private Passenger 10 Automobiles category of automobile 11 insurance. 12 13 14 WHEREAS on November 18, 2024 Security National Insurance Company ("Security National") 15 applied to the Board under the Supplemental filing option for approval of rating program changes 16 applicable to its Private Passenger Automobiles category of automobile insurance; and 17 18 WHEREAS Security National proposed various rating variable and algorithm changes resulting in 19 an overall average rate level change of -3.8%; and 20 21 WHEREAS the rate filing was forwarded to the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman 22 Limited ("Oliver Wyman") for review; and 23 24 WHEREAS on January 7, 2025 Oliver Wyman reported that it found all of Security National's 25 proposed changes to be reasonable from an actuarial standpoint; and 26 27 WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and 28 29 WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 30 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 31 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the 32 Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:
