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| 12 | WHEREAS in Order No. P.P. 58(2024) the Board suspended maximum price adjustments for |
| 13 | gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 |
| 14 | effective December 19, 2024; and |
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| 16 | WHEREAS on June 7, 2022, pursuant to Section 8.1(3) of the Petroleum Products Act, the |
| 17 | Minister of Digital Government and Service NL requested that the Board review the suitability |
| 18 | of the pricing mechanism for benchmark prices and the maximum mark-up between the |
| 19 | wholesale price to the retailer and the retail price to the consumer for all regulated fuels; and |
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| 21 | WHEREAS as part of the Petroleum Products Pricing Review (the "Review") the Board engaged |
| 22 | consultants and sought information and feedback from the industry, consumers and |
| 23 | community groups; and |
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| 25 | WHEREAS on October 1, 2024 the Board issued a consultation document for industry and public |
| 26 | input which outlined potential changes to benchmarking, mark-ups and zone differentials, and |
| 27 | other pricing matters, for Labrador; and |

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WHEREAS there are changes flowing from the Review that are applicable to Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 which are currently subject to a suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel; and

WHEREAS on March 13, 2025, the Board issued a final report for Labrador which outlined in

detail the changes to petroleum products pricing to be implemented in Labrador, including the

Board's rationale and implementation plan for those changes; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable to lift the suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 implemented pursuant to Order No. P.P. 58(2024) to allow for the implementation of the changes flowing from the Review.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 implemented pursuant to Order No. P.P. 58(2024) is lifted, effective March 21, 2025.
