**AN ORDER OF THE BOARD**

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the **Petroleum Products**  
2 **Act**, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and  
3 regulations thereunder; and  
4

5 **IN THE MATTER OF** the resupply and setting  
6 of maximum prices to be charged for gasoline  
7 motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c, and 12; and  
8

9 **IN THE MATTER OF** changes with respect to the  
10 wholesale mark-ups and total allowed mark-ups  
11 for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c, and  
12 12; and  
13

14 **IN THE MATTER OF** changes with respect to the  
15 carbon price adjustment for gasoline motor fuels  
16 in Zones 10, 11, 11c, and 12; and  
17

18 **IN THE MATTER OF** the suspension of maximum  
19 price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in  
20 Zones 10, 11, 11c, and 12.

23 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 76(2025) the Board suspended maximum price adjustments for  
24 gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11c, 12 and 14  
25 effective December 19, 2025; and  
26

27 **WHEREAS** based on delivery information provided to the Board by suppliers to the region,  
28 resupply of gasoline motor fuels to Zones 10, 11, 11c, and 12 has occurred; and  
29

30 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that it is reasonable to lift the suspension of maximum price  
31 adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12 to allow for the implementation  
32 of new benchmark prices, carbon price adjustment and mark-ups effective June 16, 2026; and

1 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 77(2025) effective December 19, 2025 the Board determined a  
2 carbon price adjustment of 8.68 cents per litre for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c, and  
3 12; and  
4

5 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 50(2026) the Board determined a carbon price adjustment of 10.50  
6 cents per litre for gasoline motor fuels for zones on the Island portion of the Province and in  
7 Zones 13 and 13a in Western Labrador effective May 7, 2026; and  
8

9 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 62(2026) the Board approved new wholesale and total allowed mark-  
10 ups for gasoline motor fuel on the Island portion of the province and in Zones 13 and 13a in  
11 Western Labrador effective May 22, 2026; and  
12

13 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that it is appropriate to align the carbon price adjustment and  
14 the mark-ups for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12 with those in the rest of the  
15 Province; and


17 **WHEREAS** maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 11a and 14 remain  
18 suspended as resupply has not started; and  
19

20 **WHEREAS** based on delivery information provided the Board is satisfied that a suspension of  
21 maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12 should be  
22 implemented following the adjustments to the benchmark prices, carbon price adjustment, and  
23 mark-ups effective June 16, 2026.

26 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


- 28 1. The suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c  
29 and 12 implemented pursuant to Order No. P.P. 76(2025) is lifted, effective June 16, 2026.  
30
- 31 2. A carbon price adjustment of 10.50 cents per litre for gasoline motor fuels is approved for  
32 Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12, effective June 16, 2026.  
33
- 34 3. The wholesale and total allowed mark-ups for gasoline motor fuels, as set out in Schedule A  
35 to this Order, are approved for Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12, effective June 16, 2026.  
36
- 37 4. The maximum prices for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12 will be adjusted  
38 effective June 16, 2026 to reflect the new cost of resupply, until further order of the Board.  
39
- 40 5. Maximum price adjustments for gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12 shall be  
41 suspended as of the scheduled maximum price adjustment effective June 16, 2026, until  
42 further order of the Board.
