AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. P.P. 83(2026)

1 **IN THE MATTER OF the Petroleum Products**
2 **Act**, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and
3 Regulations thereunder; and
4

5 **IN THE MATTER OF** the retail maximum
6 prices for full-serve gasoline motor fuel
7 and stove oil heating fuel chargeable
8 by Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc.
9 in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South.

12 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 58(2025) approved retail maximum prices that could be charged by
13 Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. (“BTCG”) in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South of 141.38
14 cents per litre for stove oil heating fuel, exclusive of applicable taxation, effective August 29,
15 2025, until further order of the Board; and

17 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 36(2026) approved retail maximum prices that could be charged by
18 BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South of 169.3 cents per litre for full-serve regular
19 gasoline, inclusive of applicable taxation, effective April 20, 2026, until further order of the
20 Board; and

22 **WHEREAS** on June 9, 2026 BTCG advised the Board that it had received deliveries of gasoline
23 motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel on June 6, 2026 and provided volumetric and delivery
24 information with respect to the petroleum products at BTCG’s retail location; and
25

26 **WHEREAS** based on its review of the cost, volumetric and delivery information provided by
27 BTCG with respect to gasoline motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel the Board is satisfied that an
28 adjustment to maximum retail prices for BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South is
29 warranted to reflect the costs of resupply; and

31 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 62(2026) the Board approved new total allowed mark-ups for
32 gasoline motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel on the Island portion of the Province and in
33 Zones 13 and 13a in Western Labrador effective May 22, 2026; and

35 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 80(2026) the Board approved new total allowed mark-ups for
36 gasoline motor fuels in Zones 10, 11, 11c and 12 in Labrador to align with the rest of the
37 Province effective June 16, 2026; and

1 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that it is appropriate to align the retail mark-ups for gasoline
2 motor fuel and stove oil heating fuel included in BTCG’s retail maximum prices with those in the
3 rest of the Province; and


5 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that a retail maximum price for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel
6 of up to 175.6 cents per litre, including applicable taxes, should be established for BTCG in Zone
7 11a - Coastal Labrador South; and
8

9 **WHEREAS** the Board finds that a retail maximum price for stove oil heating fuel of up to 148.46
10 cents per litre, excluding applicable taxes, should be established for BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal
11 Labrador South.



- 16 1. Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. can charge a retail maximum price of up to 175.6
17 cents per litre, taxes included, for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel in Zone 11a -
18 Coastal Labrador South, effective 12:01 a.m., Thursday, June 18, 2026, until further Order of
19 the Board.

- 21 2. Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. can charge a retail maximum price of up to 148.46
22 cents per litre, taxes excluded, for stove oil heating fuel in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador
23 South, effective 12:01 a.m., Thursday, June 18, 2026, until further Order of the Board.
