AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a
9 Contribution in Aid of Construction for
10 three-phase service to the Western Regional
11 Service Board, pursuant to section 41
12 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public
17 utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and

19 **WHEREAS** the Western Regional Service Board (the “Customer”) operates a waste
20 management facility located on Steel Mountain Road near the Town of St. George’s; and
21

22 **WHEREAS** on November 30, 2016 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
23 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a three-phase line extension of approximately
24 1,803 metres (the “Extension”) to provide service to the Customer’s facility; and

26 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy:
27 Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order
28 No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”) is seventy nine thousand two hundred eighteen dollars
29 (\$79,218.00), excluding HST; and

31 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(i) of the Policy states all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs
32 where the costs calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) are estimated to be greater than \$50,000
33 require approval of the Board; and
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35 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment
36 in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the
37 detriment of its other customers.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of seventy nine thousand two hundred eighteen
4 dollars (\$79,218.00), excluding HST, to provide three-phase service to the Western
5 Regional Service Board's waste management facility near the Town of St. George's is
6 approved.

8 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


