IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Newfoundland Power's proposal to issue Series AQ First Mortgage Bonds in an amount of up to \$100,000,000 to repay short term indebtedness and to refund the existing 9.00% Series AG First Mortgage Bonds of Newfoundland Power is approved subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The Series AQ First Mortgage Bonds shall be issued on or before December 31, 2020.
 - b) Newfoundland Power shall file with the Board a report specifying the terms and conditions of the bond issue within five (5) days after closing, setting out the following:
 - i. date of issue;
 - ii. term:
 - iii. maturity date;
 - iv. principal amount;
 - v. coupon rate;
 - vi. particulars of sinking fund, if any;
 - vii. price to public and to the underwriters;
 - viii. yield to the public;
 - ix. underwriting fee;
 - x. actual cost (i.e. yield) to Newfoundland Power; and
 - xi. any other material terms or conditions.
 - c) Newfoundland Power shall file with the Board a copy of the Underwriting Agreement relating to the bonds within five (5) days after closing.
 - d) Newfoundland Power shall file with the Board a report on the disposition of the proceeds no later than six months from the date of the closing.
- 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
