**Re: Timing of the Labrador Island Link (LIL) and the Labrador Transmission Assets (LTA), and 2017  
GRA forecast customer rate impacts for 2019 and associated Undertakings**

In Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") correspondence to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the "Board") on September 7, 2018, Hydro advised that it anticipated filing an update this week to provide a revised forecast of off-island purchases for 2018 and 2019, and the revised 2017 GRA customer rate projections for 2019 reflecting the revised monopole commissioning date.
