

1 Q. (Reference 2017 GRA Volume I, page 2.16) With respect to the net metering
2 program, how are customer installations categorized (i.e., households, non-
3 households, commercial, industrial, agriculture, municipal buildings, etc.) and what
4 limits are placed on each category?

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7 A. The Net Metering Program is available to residential and commercial customers.
8 Customers who apply and meet the eligibility criteria will then be categorized as
9 either domestic or general service, to correspond with the Classes of Service in
10 Hydro's approved Schedule of Rates, Rules and Regulations. "The *Net Metering*
11 *Policy Framework* sets a provincial subscription limit of 5 MW for all net metering
12 customers' generating facilities combined, and an individual generating capacity
13 limit not to exceed the customer's load requirement, to a maximum of 100 kW."¹
14 Hydro's Net Metering Program was approved by the Board in Order No. P.U.
