

1 Q. (Summary Report - Additional Cost of Service Information, page 17, lines 15 to 20) It
2 is understood that coincident with an updated fuel price forecast, Hydro will file a
3 new cost of service study reflecting the updated fuel prices, and a proposal for 2018
4 interim rates. Please confirm that this statement is correct, and provide the date in
5 April (April is only three days from now) when Hydro expects to file this
6 information.

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9 A. The statement is not correct. Hydro's application for interim rates does not require
10 Hydro to file a new cost of service study. Hydro has demonstrated a material
11 revenue deficiency for 2018, under both the Deferral Account Scenario and the
12 Expected supply Scenario, based on the information already filed through its 2017
13 General Rate Application.

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15 Hydro plans to include its application for 2018 interim rates for Newfoundland
16 Power to become effective July 1, 2018 with its annual application to update its
17 Newfoundland Power RSP adjustments, which is required by the 10th working day of
18 April (April 13, 2018).
