2 Please identify and quantify the costs of any capacity assistance agreements that  
3 will continue to be in effect following the interconnection of the Maritime Link and  
4 the interconnection of the Labrador Island Link. (Volume I (1st Revision), Chapter 3:  
5 Operations, Page 3.25, Lines 20-22)

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8 A. For the 2018 and 2019 Test Years, Hydro has provided estimates for the cost of  
9 continuing with the capacity assistance agreements with each of these industrial  
10 customers in Schedule 3-VI.

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12 Hydro presently has five capacity assistance agreements in place with its Industrial  
13 Customers: two with Corner Brook Pulp and Paper, two with Vale, and one with  
14 Praxair. Please refer to Hydro's response to CA-NLH-108.

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16 For Corner Brook Pulp and Paper, the estimates were based on the ongoing  
17 discussions that resulted in the proposed revised capacity assistance agreement  
18 that was filed with the Board for approval on October 13, 2017.<sup>1</sup> For Vale and  
19 Praxair, the estimates are based on the agreements presently in place for 2018.
