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

- 6 **PUB-Nalcor-282** Please provide the 2018 and the annual estimates from 2019 to 2039, for the
7 amount of Health and Post-Secondary Education tax (HAPSET) that the
8 Province receives from Nalcor Energy, Newfoundland Hydro and any other
9 of the Nalcor entities that remit this tax to the Province. Please provide this
10 on an annual basis by entity.

- 12 **PUB-Nalcor-283** Further to Nalcor's response to PUB-Nalcor-263, please provide the
13 potential "delta impact" under any Lower Churchill Project commercial
14 agreements (i.e. potential true-ups to Emera) assuming that none of the
15 Water Power Rental payments are made to the Province.
