12	A.	(a)	Hydro was aware of the planned discontinuation when the selection of the
13			MDR 6000 microwave radios was made in 2000. This decision was based on
14			this technology meeting all specifications for the application, the lack of an
15			equivalent product on the market, compatibility to existing installations,
16			reduction in training costs, the overall system wide spares requirements,
17			and a ten year guarantee for supply, repair, and technical support.
18			Additional spares were also procured to maintain the system beyond the ten
19			year agreement.

21		(b)	As this was a conscious decision for the above noted reasons, Hydro did not
22			attempt to receive any compensation from Alcatel. This was not necessary
23			as a ten year guarantee was provided.
