Q. With reference to lines 2 through 8 on page 35 of Mr. Brockman's Pre-Filed Evidence (August 5, 2019) please confirm whether Mr. Brockman considers it appropriate to continue the existing CBPP generation credit until a new agreement is developed or if he supports Hydro's proposal to terminate the existing agreement prior to the development of a new agreement.

A. It is Mr. Brockman's understanding of Hydro's evidence that Hydro intends to work with CBPP to develop a proposal for an arrangement to replace the CBPP generation credit as part of a planned rate design review in 2019. This would seem to allow for the development of a replacement arrangement prior to the proposed termination of the existing agreement following the commissioning of the Muskrat Falls Project. In Mr. Brockman's opinion, this appears reasonable.
