- 10 11 No. In this proceeding, we are not recommending that all generation assets, with A. 12 the exception of Muskrat Falls, be treated as common and then allocated among 13 customer classes based on a system load factor for a combined Island and Labrador 14 system. In this proceeding, we are not recommending a change in the manner in 15 which generation costs are proposed to be allocated by system. We are suggesting 16 that there may be certain generation costs such as overhead, administrative and 17 general, etc., which, in a future, integrated COS might be treated differently than in 18 the current COS.
