	opportunity costs?
A.	This response has been provided by Christensen Associates Energy Consulting.
	In general, opportunity costs are expected to be above marginal operating costs
	as a result of the source of supply on the Island being predominantly hydraulic
	production. There may be some timeframes when opportunity costs are less than
	marginal operating costs or, because of transmission constraints, Hydro's power
	system is separated from regional markets as far as market transactions are
	concerned.
