1	Q.	Reference Prefiled Evidence of Larry Brockman, regarding the system load factor:	
2		(i)	All else equal, does Mr. Brockman agree that a higher system load factor
3			implies lower unit generation costs for the mix of generation assets compared
4			to a lower system load factor?
5		(ii)	Is it Mr. Brockman's position that a utility's system load factor provides no
6			information about the utilities (sic) unit generation costs?
7			
8		A.	Yes. Mr. Brockman agrees, provided that "unit generation costs" refers to a
9			measure expressed as a cost per unit of energy produced.
10			
11		(ii)	It is not Mr. Brockman's position that a utility's system load factor provides no
12			information about the utility's unit generation costs.
