

1 Q. Where does Hydro plan to publish its Network Additions Policy so that potential new customers  
2 will have ready access to the information? Will it be made part of the Open Access Transmission  
3 Tariff?

6 A. The Network Additions Policy would be made publically available to customers on  
7 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's website. As this policy would also impact transmission  
8 service customers, it would be posted on the Newfoundland and Labrador System Operator  
9 OASIS website.

11 The Network Additions Policy would not directly impact transmission service rates and,  
12 therefore, no modifications would be required to the Open Access Transmission Tariff. Rather,  
13 this policy would impact cost allocation between customers and would therefore be referenced  
14 in associated policies and procedures relating to transmission planning, transmission service  
15 requests, and the system impact study process.
