- 1 Q: In Brattle's opinion, what are the objectives of a network additions policy that should be used by the Board to assess the various proposals?
- 4 The objectives that policymakers should consider in assessing various proposals are A. 5 reflected in the principles that we have enunciated for a network additions policy. As 6 stated on page 32-33 of Review of Existing and Proposed Network Additions Policies 7 for Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro, our recommendations are guided by the 8 principles of cost causation (and its corollary of protecting existing customers), non-9 discrimination and overall rate stability (i.e., prevention of "rate shock"). As indicated 10 in our response to NLH-PUB-006 part a, the policy should balance these guiding 11 principles with practical implementation considerations.
