The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 1620 (the "IBEW 1620") is generally interested in the entirety of the Application, and more specifically the topics/issues outlined at sections 21, 2.2, 2.3, 2.4.1, 3.2.4, report 1 - Labour Forecast: 2018 to 2020, and the expert evidence of Mr. James Coyne (Cost of Capital).

As the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for the unionized workforce of Newfoundland Power Inc., no other party has the ability and/or knowledge to appropriately represent the interests of the IBEW 1620 and its members.
