

1 **Q. Has Newfoundland Power consulted the Automobile Dealers Association to**  
2 **determine how many electric cars will be available in the province in 2022, 2023, 2024,**  
3 **and beyond? Please provide a list year over year from 2022 to 2030 of the number of**  
4 **electric vehicles which will be available for purchase in the Province in each of these**  
5 **years and the source of your information.**

7 A. *This Request for Information relates to the Electrification, Conservation and Demand*  
8 *Management Plan: 2021-2025 (the “2021 Plan”) developed in partnership by*  
9 *Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) and Newfoundland and Labrador*  
10 *Hydro (“Hydro”) (collectively, the “Utilities”) and the related Technical Conference*  
11 *presented by the Utilities on February 1, 2022. Accordingly, the response reflects*  
12 *collaboration between the Utilities.*

14 Newfoundland Power consults with the Automobile Dealers Association of  
15 Newfoundland and Labrador (“ADANL”) regarding the impact of vehicle incentive  
16 programs, the most effective ways to administer incentive programs, and issues of vehicle  
17 supply and vehicle maintenance in the province.  
18

19 The ADANL does not forecast the number of electric vehicles available in the province  
20 each year. Rather, the number of electric vehicles available for purchase in a given year  
21 is determined by individual vehicle dealerships in connection with vehicle manufacturers.  
22 As such, the requested information cannot be provided.
