5 ...it may be necessary to extend the distribution interconnection lines to each
6 diesel plant directly instead of the distribution feeder. This additional cost is
7 excluded for capital cost estimates included in this technical note however could
8 increase the cost further than is currently contemplated.

9 Please provide the capital cost estimate for the extension of the distribution interconnection
10 lines to each diesel plant directly instead of the closest point on the distribution feeder.

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13 A. The capital cost of extending the pole lines, a total of 2.8 km, to provide direct connection to the
14 diesel generating stations in St. Lewis and Mary's Harbour is estimated at approximately
15 \$180,000 and \$240,000, respectively. No extension would be required for Port Hope Simpson.
