2 Regarding the statement that the 2021 Plan will provide 0.5 cents/kWh in rate mitigation by
3 2034, please provide the decomposition of the Plan’s rate mitigating effect due to electrification
4 and due to CDM.

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7 A. *This Request for Information relates to the Electrification, Conservation and Demand*
8 *Management Plan 2021–2025 (“2021 Plan”) developed in partnership by Newfoundland and*
9 *Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) and Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) (collectively,*
10 *the “Utilities”) and the related Technical Conference presented by the Utilities on February 1,*
11 *2022. Accordingly, the response reflects collaboration between the Utilities.*

12 Conservation and Demand Management programs provide direct bill savings for customers.
13 Please refer to Hydro’s response to TC-CA-NLH-030. The rate mitigating benefit for customers of
14 approximately 0.5¢/kWh by 2034 relates to electrification initiatives associated with the Island
15 Interconnected System’s customers.

16 Please refer to Newfoundland Power’s response to PUB-NP-009 for customer rate impacts
17 associated with the Utilities’ electrification initiatives over the period 2021–2034.
