

- 1 **Q. (Application Volume 1, page 2-13) Do the Customer Electrification Costs given in**
2 **Table 2-3 include the costs of NP’s proposed EV charging network project that was**
3 **included in its 2022 Capital Budget Application?**
4
- 5 A. The customer electrification costs provided in Table 2-3, as referenced in this Request for
6 Information, do not include the capital expenditures proposed by Newfoundland Power to
7 construct an EV Charging Network. The “Program” costs provided in Table 2-3 do,
8 however, include operating costs associated with the ongoing operation and maintenance
9 of the EV Charging Network.¹ See response to Request for Information CA-NP-031 for
10 additional information on the costs included in Table 2-3.

¹ See the *2021 Electrification, Conservation and Demand Management Application, Volume 1, Exhibit 1*, which states that costs to operate Company-owned charging stations would be included in the proposed Electrification Cost Deferral Account.
