# NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Newfoundland Power Inc.  
2023 Capital Budget Application

## THE APPLICATION

On June 29, 2022 the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities received an application from Newfoundland Power Inc. requesting an Order:

- i) approving proposed construction and purchase of improvements or additions to its property to be completed in 2023 in the amount of \$93,292,000;
- ii) approving proposed multi-year construction and purchase of improvements and additions to its property in the amount of \$10,483,000 in 2023 and \$10,645,000 in 2024; and
- iii) fixing and determining its average rate base for 2021 in the amount of \$1,202,946,000.

The total proposed 2023 Capital Budget is \$123,463,000. The application may be viewed on the Board's website and copies are available upon request to the Board Secretary. Any person interested in viewing a paper copy may contact Newfoundland Power by email at (whnoel@newfoundlandpower.com).

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Anyone can participate in the application by becoming an intervenor, by making a presentation or by submitting a letter of comment. Intervenor submissions and requests to make a presentation must be filed with the Board **by 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 20, 2022**. Letters of comment must be filed with the Board **by 3:00 p.m., Friday, October 14, 2022**. Intervenor submissions must satisfy the requirements set out in section 9 of the *Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities Regulations, 1996*. All participants must provide full contact information including name, address and phone number.
