

1 **PUB-NLH-1** In the *2012 Capital Expenditures and Carryover Report*, page 5, Hydro has
2 indicated in its Carryovers to 2013 that \$3,743,600 remains to be expended in
3 2013 on the Upgrade Gas Turbine Plan Life Extension – Hardwoods project.
4 In the report provided with the current application, *Hardwoods Gas Turbine*
5 *Alternator Replacement 2013*, page 14, Hydro states that \$2.1 million of the
6 originally approved project will no longer be necessary.

8 Please provide details of the work that remains of the original project to be
9 undertaken in 2013, and explain how the remaining approved amount of the
10 original project, \$1,643,600, relates to the current request for approval of an
11 expenditure of \$8,015,800.
