6		Diesel), 2.5G (Gov't General Service Diesel), 4.1G (Gov't Street and Area Lighting) or
7		any other rate classes applicable to Government customers, although rates for
8		Classes 1.2G, 2.1G, 2.2G and 4.1G are included for approval in Hydro's 2013
9		Amended General Rate Application.
10		Please provide a revised Cost of Service for 2014 and for 2015 to include rate
11		classes 1.2G, 2.1G, 2.2G, 4.1G and any other Government customers.
12

14	A.	In Schedule 1.2, pages 3 of 6 and 4 of 6, the revenues and the costs for the
15		Government Domestic Diesel customers are included with the Domestic Diesel
16		customers provided in the schedule. Likewise, the revenues and the costs for the
17		Government General Service Diesel customers are included with the General
18		Service Diesel customers provided in the schedule and the same grouping practice
19		applies for Street and Area lighting.
20		
21		The reason for grouping the costs and revenues in the cost of service by customer
22		type is to determine the unit costs on the Isolated Systems for use in determining
23		the proposed rates for the Government customers.
24

26		revenue component for each rate to the totals provided in Schedule 1.2.
