The other 1.2 million increase relates to the portion of total administrative and general operating and maintenance expense allocated to the Labrador Interconnected System which is based on direct operating and maintenance expense. It has increased from 0.3 million to 1.5 million (see Exhibit 13, Schedule 2.4E, Page 1 of 2) due to the increase in direct transmission operating and maintenance expense of 2.9 million.
