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

3                    assets (e.g., by size of pole, voltage of equipment, etc) and identifies the  
4                    general function the micro asset relates to (e.g. "Transmission" "Terminal  
5                    Stations", "Generation", etc). Please provide a breakdown of the lists  
6                    provided by Hydro's responses to IN-NLH-114 and IC-NLH-88 which  
7                    identifies, by individual customer, each macro asset (e.g., transmission  
8                    line from X to Y, terminal station at Z, generation plant A, etc.) that these  
9                    individual micro assets relate to, the date that macro asset was placed in  
10                    service, and the date the macro asset was specifically assigned to the  
11                    individual customer, if the assignment date is different from the in service  
12                    date.
- 13    **IC-NLH-98**                    With reference to IC-NLH-97, for each macro asset specifically assigned  
14                    to an individual customer, provide the distinct and detailed rationale, role  
15                    and justification for the specific assignment to that customer.
- 16    **IC-NLH-99**                    With reference to IC-NLH-97, for each specifically assigned macro asset,  
17                    identify all projects undertaken on that specifically assigned macro asset,  
18                    by year, since the last GRA, including the capital cost of each project.

20                    on specifically assigned macro assets since the last GRA, please provide  
21                    a description and chronology of communication with the affected  
22                    customer, including notification of the required capital work, capital cost

24                    undertaking the work, any revisions to these capital cost estimates and  
25                    rates provided to the customer during or after the course of the work, and  
26                    the current estimates of capital cost and rate impacts.
- 27    **IC-NLH-101**                    Please identify all changes in the determinations regarding specifically  
28                    assigned assets since the last GRA (e.g., with reference to IC-NLH-97,  
29                    whether classes of micro assets, or individual macro assets, that were  
30                    previously not specifically assigned to customers being now classified as

1 specifically assigned) and the detailed rationale for and timing of each  
2 change.
