Please accept this letter as my formal request for Intervenor Status at the Investigation and Hearing into Supply Issues and Power Outages on the Island Interconnected system.

While my interest will be on whether load requirements on the Island can meet near term requirements, my primary issue is the reliability of the Muskrat Falls transmission line from Labrador to Solider's Pond.

A significant aspect of this issue is the reliability of the submarine cable crossing the Strait of Belle Isle.

I would be pleased to elaborate on these issues at your pre-hearing conference on Feb. 5, 2014.

As a resident and former MHA from Labrador I have followed the development of this project for many years.

As a former Member of the NL Hydro Board of Directors I have had exposure to these issues.
