

**Re: The Board's Investigation and Hearing into Supply Issues and Power Outages  
on the Island Interconnected System – Requests for Information, Phase One**

Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (Hydro) is in receipt of Requests for Information (RFIs) numbered DD-NLH-113 to DD-NLH-121 filed on October 30, 2014. Pursuant to the Board's correspondence of October 28, and 31, 2014 all responses to information requests for Phase One of the public outage inquiry are required to be filed no later than November 13, 2014, including responses to information requests filed by October 30, being the final filing date for Phase One RFIs. In this regard Hydro has reviewed Mr. Dumaresque's RFIs noted above and wishes to advise the Board that it intends to respond to DD-NLH-117, 118, 119 and 121 by November 13, as these relate to Phase One of the review, and will be responding to the remainder of Mr. Dumaresque's recently filed RFIs dealing with Phase Two matters in accordance with the schedule for responses to Phase Two RFIs once the same is established by the Board.
