**Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro**

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Dear Sirs/Madams:

**Re: Investigation and Hearing into Supply Issues and Power Outages on the Island Interconnected System – Phase Two – Availability of Information and Ongoing Reporting and Monitoring**

In its letter of August 16, 2017 the Board advised that it had engaged Liberty to assist in determining a monitoring framework to track progress against milestones related to the integration of the Muskrat Falls, Labrador Island and Maritime Link assets into the Island Interconnected System (IIS). Preliminary meetings between Liberty and Hydro were held in September, 2017.

It has been determined that Hydro will provide Liberty on a quarterly basis with updated progress information on the schedule for integration and Liberty will then provide the Board a quarterly report with its analysis. This will allow the Board to monitor the progress of the integration of the new assets into the IIS which is critical for the Board to assess the adequacy and reliability of supply for the IIS both prior to and after integration. Hydro will provide Liberty with its first progress update for the fourth quarter of 2017 with Liberty's first report being

available by the end of the first quarter in 2018. Copies of Liberty's reports will be provided to the parties.
