Re: Monthly Update on the Integration of Power Supply Facilities to the Island Interconnected System – Request for Filing Date Change

Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) provides a monthly update to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (“Board”) on the integration of power supply facilities to the Island Interconnected System as per the Board’s request of November 21, 2019. Through recent discussions between Hydro, Board staff, the Board’s consultant (The Liberty Consulting Group) and Nalcor Energy, a change to the filing date of the report has been mutually identified. Hydro requests that the filing scheduled for November 25, 2020 instead be filed on December 3, 2020 and for future reports to be filed on the Thursday following the first Wednesday of each month. For example, the first four months of 2021 will have a schedule as follows: January 7, 2021; February 4, 2021; March 4, 2021; and April 8, 2021.
