4 General Electric and with respect to responsibility for potential damage to LIL or other
5 equipment connected to the ac network.

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8 A. It is confirmed. Section 14.4 of the Transmission Asset Interconnection Agreement between
9 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro, Labrador-Island Link Limited Partnership and Labrador-
10 Island Link Operating Corporation reads:

11 “For the avoidance of doubt, it is the Parties' intent that, subject to any right a
12 Person may have to seek compensation from a third party who caused the Loss
13 or from insurance, each Person that is indemnified pursuant to Section 14.1,
14 Section 14.2 and Section 14.3 will be responsible for and will bear the risk of
15 Losses to its own personal property, facilities, equipment, materials and
16 improvements, howsoever incurred, including Losses resulting from another
17 Party's performance of its obligations hereunder or the action or inaction of
18 another Party, or its Affiliates or Representatives.”
