To capture uncertainties and ongoing challenges that system planning faces for the 9 Newfoundland and Labrador electrical system, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro is committed 10 to continuing to file near-term reliability reports in May and November as well as annual 11 updates to the Reliability and Resource Adequacy Study in November. The near-term reliability 12 reports will continue to analyze system reliability over a five-year period and the updates to the Reliability and Resource Adequacy Study over a ten-year period. In addition, annual Winter 13 14 Readiness reports will continue to be filed in October, with scheduled updates in November and 15 December, in advance of each upcoming winter period.
