Q. What would happen if the Board were to disallow costs for feeder improvement programs for the next two years? If the Board were to disallow cost recovery, would Hydro do the work anyway since you believe the work is so important for customer reliability?

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A.

Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") is legislated not to proceed with the construction, purchase or lease of improvements or additions to its property without prior approval of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities ("Board"). If the Board disallowed costs for feeder improvement programs, Hydro would not complete the above specified work. If the feeder improvement programs are not complete it would create a growing backlog of deficiencies that would have a negative impact on future costs and present an increased risk to distribution system reliability, which would potentially impact customer service.
