1	Q.	In paragraph 17 of the Application, Hydro states that, if the requested delay is granted, its next
2		General Rate Application may not be filed until mid-2021. In paragraph 14 of the Application,
3		Hydro estimates it will require nine months from the date the revised financial structure for the
4		Muskrat Falls PPA and Government's rate mitigation plan have been finalized and publicly
5		communicated to prepare its General Rate Application filing. These statements, read together,
6		indicate that Hydro anticipates these preconditions for preparation of its next GRA will be met
7		by Fall 2020. Based on what information does Hydro anticipate these preconditions will be met
8		by Fall 2020? To Hydro's knowledge or understanding, has this information been updated or
9		revised to reflect the impact of the Covid-19 public health emergency?

Although Hydro believes the timing of the pre-conditions reflected in the request will be 12 Α. impacted by the COVID-19 public health emergency, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro 13 14 ("Hydro") does not know when these pre-conditions will be met. It is for this reason that Hydro 15 proposed filing the next General Rate Application ("GRA") on a date to be determined that is subsequent to the completion of the pre-conditions and did not propose a specific fixed date. 16 17 Approval of the proposals in the Application will enable Hydro to prepare a GRA filing that will reasonably reflect the costs that Hydro will incur in providing electrical service to its customers 18 for use in determining proposed customer rates. 19
