9		Is it appropriate to delay recovery of these costs until the conclusion of the GRA and the
10		implementation of rates?

15		In Hydro's view, the implementation of interim rates during the General Rate Application
16		("GRA") process is an appropriate means by which to begin recovery of test year costs in
17		advance of the conclusion of a GRA.
