On page 26 of Schedule 1: Evidence of the Application Hydro notes that "To a large degree, the Q. 1 2 requirement to continue operation as a fully operational facility requires Hydro to continue to maintain its personnel, equipment inventory, fuel inventory, assets, contractor agreements, etc. 3 to similar levels as required for the Holyrood TGS' full operation prior to Project commissioning. 4 5 Hydro estimates an approximate staff decrease of 50 full-time equivalents upon transitioning to 6 the post-steam operational mode." 7 Please explain why Hydro is not proposing to include Holyrood TGS non-fuel O&M savings into the deferral account. 8 9 10 11 Α. Under the current schedule, post-steam operational mode is to begin in April 2023. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") expects that 2023 will be a test year for the next 12 general rate application ("GRA"). Therefore, Hydro will give consideration to the non-fuel 13 14 savings at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station in preparing its GRA test year forecast.
