6	Α.	Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") Hydro Command Centre Upgrade project <sup>1</sup> is an
7		investment in a software asset that Hydro previously purchased and maintains. The purpose of
8		this upgrade is to extend the life of the current meter management solution until the PLX
9		meters are fully replaced in future projects.
10		Hydro's PLX meter reading system communicates over Hydro's secure private network. Using a
11		third party would result in additional network infrastructure investments to ensure a secure and
12		reliable system. Therefore, leasing or Software as a Service <sup>2</sup> for this solution is not viable at this
13		time.
