6 Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") capital risk evaluation within its asset A. 7 management program provides the baseline risk (i.e., pre-implementation), residual risk (i.e., 8 post-implementation), and the mitigation value, provided in the 2023 Capital Budget 9 Application<sup>1</sup> for projects and programs in the Renewal, Service Enhancement and General Plant 10 investment classifications, as required by the provisional Capital Budget Application Guidelines.<sup>2</sup> 11 This information is contained in a table titled "Risk Scoring Pre- and Post-Implementation" within each applicable project or program report within Volume II of Hydro's 2022 Capital 12 Budget Application. For reference, Appendix F of Hydro's Capital Budget Overview<sup>3</sup> contains 13 14 Hydro's Capital Risk Rating Matrix used to calculate the risk scoring.
