1 Q. If the Holyrood plant is expected to continue to have a base loading function from 2022
2 onwards, has Hydro, in its Capital Plan, taken fully into account the capital projects necessary or
3 prudent to maintain that function from 2022 onwards? If not, what are the capital projects that
4 can be foreseeably expected to be necessary or prudent to maintain Holyrood's base loading
5 function from 2022 onwards?

A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") Five-Year Capital Plan¹ includes capital expenditures necessary or prudent to maintain the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station ("Holyrood TGS") in a base loading function until March 31, 2024, as well as capital expenditures necessary to support the Holyrood TGS as a synchronous condensing facility through 2027.
