Q. Reference: Hydro response to IC-NLH-001

Has Hydro made or commissioned any review, or is it aware of any third party which has made a review, of reliability of service metrics for its industrial customers as compared to reliability of service metrics for the industrial customers of electricity utilities in other Canadian jurisdictions? If not, would it be possible for Hydro to make or commission such a review, and if so, is there any reason why Hydro would be disinclined from doing so?

A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") has not made or commissioned any review, nor is Hydro aware of any third party that has made a review of reliability of service metrics for its industrial customers, as compared to reliability of service metrics for the industrial customers of electric utilities in other Canadian jurisdictions.

The Electricity Canada Bulk Electrical System Committee, of which Hydro and other Canadian utilities are members, is constituted to enable the dissemination of reliability performance information and methodologies with respect to electrical supply transmission delivery points. In 2023, Hydro will survey these members to determine if they gather reliability information related to their industrial customers and whether any such utilities would share their methodology and performance metrics. Hydro will report survey results to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities in the fourth quarter of 2023.
