Why was the work included in the CBA if it was not needed? 6 7 8 9 While Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") capital budget applications ("CBA") are Α. 10 prepared using the most accurate information known to Hydro at the time of application filing, 11 there are instances where subsequent analyses completed prior to project execution indicate 12 that planned work is no longer required. Capital plans are also updated due to changes in 13 operational decisions that occur within the 12 months or more that elapse between the 14 submission of a CBA and the execution of the work. The reassessment of the insulator replacements at the Churchill Falls and Roddickton Terminal 15 Stations, which determined that this work was not immediately required, was completed prior 16 17 to project execution but post-CBA filing. For the Churchill Falls Terminal Station, the intention 18 and ability to proceed with the decommissioning of transmission line L1301 led to this 19 determination. For the Roddickton Terminal Station, this determination was due to the 20 indefinite de-energization of the insulators planned for replacement. 21 In addition, a portion of the major transformer refurbishment at Jackson's Arm Terminal Station 22 was cancelled (being the internal inspection). Subsequent to the filing of the 2020 CBA, it was 23 determined that the internal inspection was not immediately required due to updated condition 24 information. A portion of the major refurbishment of the transformers at the Hampden 25 Terminal Station was also cancelled; however, this portion was not in the original scope as
