Does Hydro anticipate filing or intend to file any additional supplementary capital budget applications for 2024 capital expenditures? If yes, list the capital expenditures and explain why they are not included in the 2024 Capital Budget Application.

A. Supplemental applications with 2024 capital expenditures are those listed in Table 1 of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") revised 2024 Capital Budget Application ("CBA").¹ "Section Replacement and Weld Refurbishment for Bay d'Espoir Hydroelectric Generating Facility Penstock 1" was approved by the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities ("Board") in Board Order No. P.U. 6(2023)², "Purchase and Replace Last Stage Blades – Holyrood Units 1 and 2" was approved in Board Order No. P.U. 12(2023),³ and "Construction and Installation of Ultra-Fast Electric Vehicle Charging Stations" was approved in Board Order No. P.U. 21(2023).⁴ "Long-Term Supply for Southern Labrador" is currently before the Board.⁵

As indicated in its correspondence of August 18, 2023 accompanying the revised 2024 CBA, Hydro plans to file an application, supplemental to the approved 2023 CBA, for advancement of the purchase of a spare generator step-up ("GSU") transformer following the failure of Bay d'Espoir Transformer T6 in July 2023. This proposed project will include 2023, 2024, and 2025 capital expenditures. The purchase of a spare GSU transformer was included in Hydro's original 2024 CBA, but was subsequently withdrawn in Revision 1 to attempt to expedite the purchase in order to mitigate the risk of GSU transformer failure. Hydro plans to file this supplemental application in the coming weeks.
