



NOTICE OF APPLICATION

NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO 2027 CAPITAL BUDGET APPLICATION

THE APPLICATION

On July 14, 2026 the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (“Board”) received an application from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) requesting an Order:

- i) approving its 2027 Capital Budget in the amount of \$156,355,300;
- ii) approving capital expenditures for projects with expenditures in 2027 and in future years; and
- iii) fixing and determining its average rate base for 2025 in the amount of \$2,486,782,000.

Hydro’s total proposed capital expenditures for 2027 are estimated to be \$545.6 million. This includes additional major capital projects associated with the Bay d’Espoir Hydroelectric Generating Station, the purchase and installation of an Avalon Combustion Turbine and other supplemental projects. Separate Board proceedings are established for the review of these expenditures.

Anyone can participate in the 2027 Capital Budget Application by becoming an intervenor, by making a presentation to the Board or by submitting a letter of comment. Intervenor submissions and requests to make a presentation must be filed with the Board **by 3:00 p.m., Friday, August 7, 2026**. Letters of comment must be filed with the Board **by 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 18, 2026**. Intervenor submissions must satisfy the requirements set out in section 9 of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities Regulations, 1996. All participants must provide full contact information including name, address and phone number.
